

INSTRUCTIONS FOLLOWING ROOT CANAL THERAPY



Phil MaCavity says "Just Floss 'Em"

1. Try to avoid chewing on the tooth being treated.
2. Do not chew gum, it sticks to temporary restorations and is difficult to remove.
3. A medicinal taste may be noticeable for several days following treatment.
4. Some soreness is to be expected after each treatment. If this occurs, 1 or 2 aspirins or other prescribed painkiller should restore comfort. Extra strength TYLENOL and ADVIL in combination are very effective for pain and inflammation.
5. If discomfort or swelling occurs, take the tablets as prescribed and call our office.
6. Should any condition arise which causes you concern, notify the office or leave a message with the answering service.
7. Special Instructions if any are given must be followed

A REMINDER

Upon completion of root canal therapy you will need to have the tooth restored with a gold post to reinforce it and a restoration such as a crown.

You should make appointments accordingly for:

**A Gold post
And a Gold or Porcelain-gold crown**
